

## TVU Programme Transfer Arrangements for Existing and Previous LCCH Students

All students wishing to transfer into any of the TVU postgraduate suite of awards will be required to complete both formative and summative assessments of the pre-requisite award as appropriate to the level of entry.

For example: A LCCH student who has completed LCCH Diploma will be required to submit and pass relevant PG Cert formative and summative assessments:- Reflective Account, Case Study, Practical Exam – Clinical Studies Module, 1 x 3500 word assessment – Psychotherapeutic Studies Module, before being eligible to Advance Stand into either the PGDip or its constituent CPPDs

LCCH will provide appropriate bridging courses for students who hold previous LCCH qualifications and wish to obtain Advance Standing via the bridging assessments into the postgraduate suite of Awards. These bridging courses will be scheduled during the 2009/2010 academic term.

## Detailed Bridging Courses

### Bridging from LCCH Certificate

Those holding an LCCH Certificate whose examinations were held **before March 2008** will need to:

- Participate in a 1 weekend CPPD bridging course
- Successfully complete all Level 6 CPPD module assessments

Successful students can then enter the PGCert.

### Bridging From LCCH Diploma

Those holding an LCCH Diploma whose examinations were held **before January 2009** will need to:

- Participate in a 2 weekend bridging course
- Successfully complete the TVU PG Cert module assessments, both formative and summative

Successful students can then enter the PG Dip.

## **Bridging Weekends**

These weekends provide students with the opportunity to access as appropriate to their level of bridging, the content and skills required to enable them to successfully the related module assessments.

Students wishing to **bridge into PGCert** will need to engage with reflection as a process and the relevant reflective models in this weekend before attempting the Level 6 CPPD formative and summative assessments.

Students wishing to **bridge into PGDip or its constituent CPPDs** will need to cover the following subjects in this weekend before attempting the PG Cert module formative and summative assessments.

## LCCH Practitioner Diploma in Clinical Hypnosis Course

Those holding a LCCH Practitioner Studies Diploma whose examinations were held **before Jan 2009** will need to:

- Participate in a two or four weekend revision course (depending on the level of bridging required)
- Successfully complete both CPPD Practitioner Studies module assessments.

Students bridging from the pre TVU eight weekend Practitioner Diploma (courses held **between 2006 until present inclusive**) will need to do:

- EMI Therapy
- Eating Disorders
- Bulimia Nervosa
- Anorexia Nervosa

## **LCCH Cognitive Behavioural Hypnotherapy Diploma Course**

Those holding a LCCH Cognitive Behavioural Hypnotherapy Diploma whose examinations were held prior to **July 2008** are required to successfully complete the TVU CPPD Cognitive Behavioural Therapy module assessments.

No bridging course will be required as the content and practice skills currently being delivered are the same as those that of the CPPD.

## **Bridging into MSc**

Those LCCH students who have successfully completed the:

- LCCH Diploma Clinical Hypnosis
- LCCH Practitioner Diploma Clinical Hypnosis

Will be required to successfully complete the

- practical assessment from the PGCert Clinical Studies module
- psychodynamic and cognitive behavioural therapies (Psychotherapeutic Studies module assignment 2)
- both summative assessments Practitioner Studies module
- both summative assessments CBH module
